AGM TREASURER'S REPORT 2021

Once again our year was affected by the pandemic - the restrictions and health concerns- surrounded our activities. So, a big thank you to all the members and especially the Committee for your continued support. Copies of this report and the accounts, together with all the other reports can be found on our website.

The accounts are set out with details of this and the preceding year, to enable a comparison to be made.

Our income was severely limited by the pandemic; the cancellation of the winter series of talks at the beginning of 2021, the decision to not charge upon resumption of the talks in October and the reduced attendance since. Sales of our guides and maps reflected the decreased number of visitors to the town. So consequently overall income decreased by just over £1500 to £1233.

We made two special donations last year: £500 to support the Christmas lights and £1405 to repair benches we own. Consequently our expenses exceeded our income by about £1500, but in line with our desire to reduce our unrestricted funds.
